We continue to be vigilant with best practices for staying healthy and look forward to the time when our clients and staff can be back together. I also wanted to recognize the outpatient women who persevere in their recovery every day while they participate in our telehealth services. My message to you is that this time will pass and you will be even stronger than you were before the pandemic. You are not alone! Newly Appointed Executive Committee


